*The Confession of Faith (*from the Westminster Shorter Catechism in Modern English*, Questions 43 and 44)

Q.43. What introduces the ten commandments?

A. These words introduce the ten commandments: "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery."

Q.44. What does the introduction to the ten commandments teach us?

A. The introduction to the ten commandments teaches us that, because God is Lord and is our God and redeemer, we must keep all His commandments.

The Confession of Sin (*from Leading in Worship*, pp. 28-29)

O Lord our God, we come to You as Your sons and servants, grateful for the redemption that is ours in Jesus Christ, and yet aware of our continuing need of Your grace. We confess that we have sinned against You. We have broken Your commandments. We have fallen short of Your glory. We have not loved You with all our heart, mind, soul, and strength. We've not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We were born in sin and have continued to sin. Yet You warn that

whoever keeps the whole law and stumbles at one point is guilty of all. We acknowledge our guilt. We rightly fall under Your curse and judgment. Have mercy upon us. O Lord, in Jesus' name. Blot out our transgressions. Wash us from our iniquities; deliver us from bloodguiltiness. Forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Remove our transgressions as far as the east is from the west; cast all our sins behind Your back and remember them no more. (Rom. 3:23; I John 3:4; Rom. 6:23; Matt. 22:37-39; James 2:10; Psalm 51; I John 1:9; Psalm 103:12; Isaiah 38:17; Jer. 31:34)
