DUST TO GLORY BY R.C. SPROUL

Take I-695 to I-83 north

Travel 14 miles to exit 31, Middletown Road

At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Middletown Road

Travel approximately 5 miles to First Fruits Farm; the farm is on the right with the volunteer entrance marked (flag and sign)
